2 Update on Barwon Heads Pedestrian Safety Project.

Mark Tonkin from VicRoads presented a progress-to-date report to our June meeting

The options being considered and being tested in traffic modeling are:

Pedestrian island upgrades / traffic calming or traffic signals
(Bridge Road & Hitchcock Ave) or Zebra crossings, without or without flashing lights, or with speed humps, and finally the Shared Space Concept in Bridge Street, ie. a mix of slow moving vehicles and a median for pedestrians

VicRoads will hold open community information session in August so you can view the various options.

3 Dangerous footpaths. What can be done?

The BHA Committee & concerned residents met with Wiliam Tieppo the new General Manager, City Services to inspect our old footpaths. Nothing seems to be forthcoming from this meeting so the BHA needs to confer with members about the way forward to ensure CoGG acts on its responsibility regarding the maintenance of safe footpaths.
